- Survey Vessel as required

VHF Channel Monitored:

- When vessels are on site CXP will actively monitor for vessels bound for Centerm.

Special Requests or Additional Information:

- CXP will coordinate directly with MCTS Victoria regarding any vessel movement within, in, or out of Centerm Harbour; and, will liaise with the Harbour Master and adjacent marine operations, including SeaBus and Terminal Operator to coordinate work activities.
