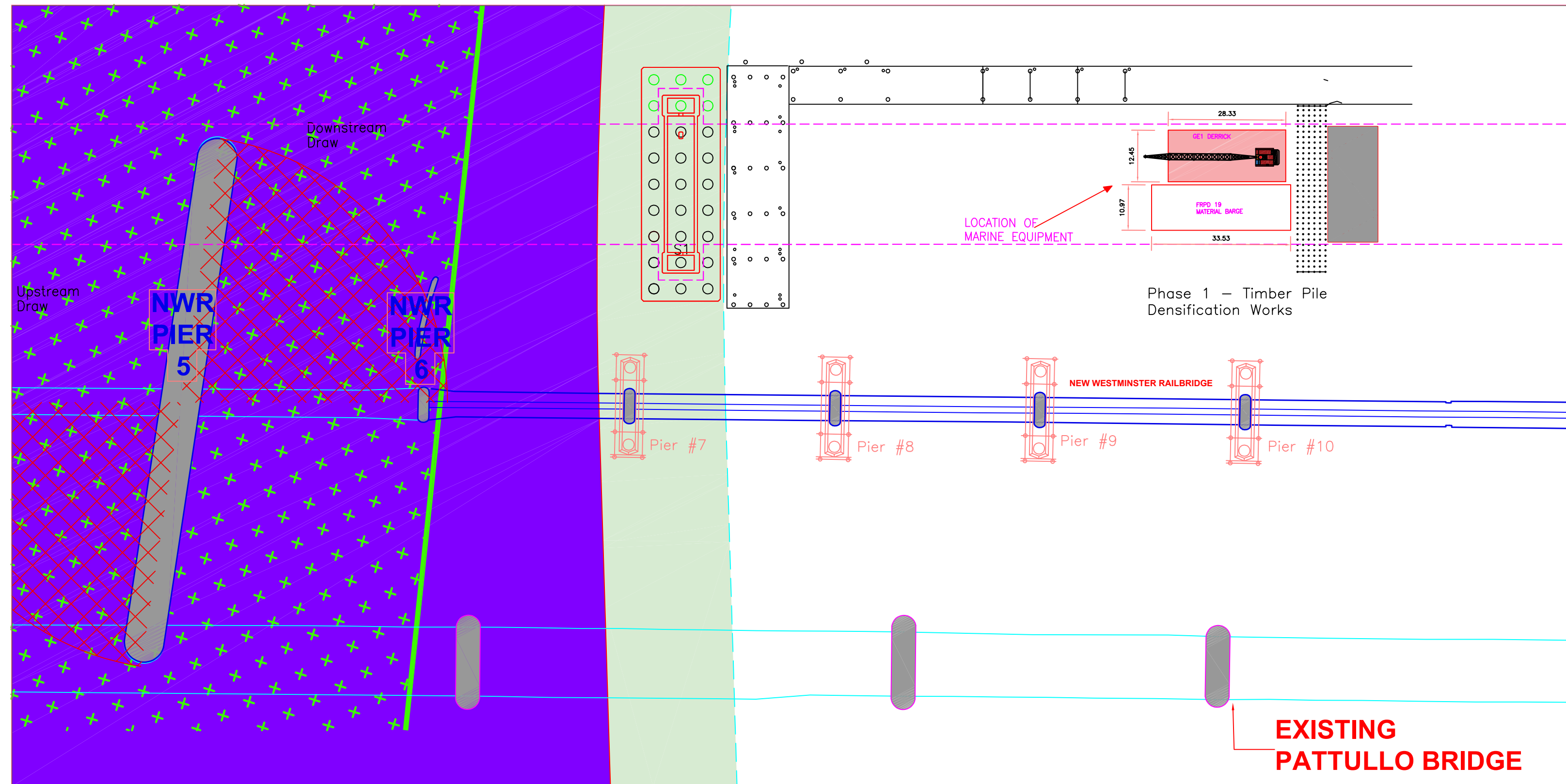
No restriction to the main downstream, upstream or auxiliary navigational channels.
